

Dr Kok Choong Seng

Dr Kok graduated from USM in 1987. After completing his housemanship at Hospital Taiping, he joined the Malaysian Armed Forces. In 1991 he went to University Malaya to pursue his post-graduate training in orthopaedics. Upon completion in 1995 he went back to serve the Armed Forces. During that time he had served in various units of the Army, Air Force and Navy; including a stint with the United Nations peace-keeping force in Bosnia-Herzegovina. During his service in the Armed Forces Dr Kok had extensive experience with the treatment of sports injuries; especially of the knee and shoulder.

In 2002 Dr Kok completed his military service at the Lumut Armed Forces Hospital and went into private practice at Pantai Klang Specialist Medical Centre. Currently he is practicing at the Spine and Joint Centre, Pantai Hospital Kuala Lumpur. He specializes in the treatment of sports injuries of the knee. These include ligament reconstructions and meniscus repairs and resection.

Dr Kok has been a council member of MASM since 2000; becoming Honorary Treasurer in 2004 and Vice President in 2014.
