Dr Chan Kin Yuen currently is a Consultant Orthopaedic and Trauma Surgeon practicing in Gleneagles Hospital Kuala Lumpur and Subang Jaya Medical Centre, Subang Jaya Selangor. He specializes in Orthopaedic Sports Medicine, Shoulder and Elbow, Knee and Foot and Ankle Surgery. In particular his interest is in arthroscopic surgery in the management of sports injuries involving the knee, shoulder, foot and ankle, shoulder and elbow replacement and unicondylar (partial) knee replacement.

He graduated from University of Nottingham and completed his postgraduate training in Liverpool University, UK. During his training he was a Clinical Fellow in Massachusetts General Hospital, an affiliated hospital to Harvard Medical School, Boston, USA. He also trained as a Fellow in Orthopaedic Sports Medicine and Shoulder and Elbow Surgery in Prince of Wales Hospital, Sydney Australia. He returned to Malaysia in 2001 and was appointed Assoc Prof and Head of the Orthopaedic Sports Medicine Unit, Department of Orthopaedic Surgery in the University of Malaya. He started private practice since 2004.

He was the past president of the Malaysian Association of Sports Medicine for 2 terms. He is the current Vice-president of the Malaysian Association of Sports Medicine (MASM) and vice-president of Asian Federation of Sports Medicine (AFSM). He is also a medical committee member of the Olympic Council of Malaysia (OCM). He is regularly involved in the training of postgraduate, undergraduate, nursing, paramedical and sports science professionals and courses organized locally and internationally including continuing medical education for general practitioners.
