Dr. Siew Li Goh is a clinician and medical lecturer in Sports Medicine in University of Malaya (UM). She obtained her PhD from University of Nottingham for her work on network meta-analysis in knee and hip osteoarthritis. Network meta-analysis is a technique used to generate evidence that is crucial for formulating clinical guidelines and practices. Other than evidence-based medicine, she also has an interest in biomechanics of lower limb and badminton. She is leading the biomechanics interest group, under the newly formed Sports and Exercise Medicine Research and Education Group (SEMREG), to advance the research agenda of the Sports Medicine. Currently, she is involved in few projects, funded by local and international grants, as investigator and as supervisor of research students. It is her belief that the most important role of an educator is to assist the students to develop their own potential and becoming independent and life-long learners. At the same time, she also strongly advocates practices that support the development of trainees into empathetic and conscientious sports physicians and member of society.
